During Passover I realised how much time I spend reading about food, cooking, sharing food and eating. Last week I attended Sustainability Victoria's Food Waste Avoidance Workshop as a representative of JECO. The week before the workshop we had to fill in a <u>food waste diary</u>. It's an exercise I can recommend - you'll be surprised. In Victoria, households spend about **\$800** per year on food they don't use and eventually throw away.
